Notice how this house was positioned on the lot too close to the wall to allow a vehicle to easily pass between the wall and the porch, even after the pilings laying on the ground are removed.

This house was built by the Galveston Housing Authority, the City agency that wants to build a mixed-income development that will “transform” the City! The total price tag for the mixed-income development may push \$300 million dollars.

The older Oaks II development is already plagued with many unresolved construction and Hurricane-like “repair” problems.
